## The Nicene Creed

Alex Farmer and Fr. John Wallace as candidates and ask that you would bless and strengthen both them and their families and give them your peace during this season of discernment, through Jesus Christ our Lord.

And to all your people give your heavenly grace, especially to this Congregation, that with reverent and obedient hearts we

may hear and receive your holy Word, and serve you in holiness and righteousness all the days of our lives.
