The Lesson

A Reading from Acts 15:36-16:5

³⁶ And after some days Paul said to Barnabas, "Let us return and visit the brothers in every city where we proclaimed the word of the Lord, and see how they are." ³⁷ Now Barnabas wanted to take with them John called Mark. ³⁸ But Paul thought best not to take with them one who had withdrawn from them in Pamphylia and had not gone with them to the work. ³⁹ And there arose a sharp disagreement, so that they separated from each other. Barnabas took Mark with him and sailed away to Cyprus, ⁴⁰ but Paul chose Silas and departed, having been commended by the brothers to the grace of the Lord. ⁴¹ And he went through Syria and Cilicia, strengthening the churches.

Paul came also to Derbe and to Lystra. A disciple was there, named Timothy, the son of a Jewish woman who was a believer, but his father was a Greek. ²He was well spoken of by the brothers at Lystra and Iconium. ³Paul wanted Timothy to accompany him, and he took him and circumcised him because of the Jews who were in those places, for they all knew that his father was a Greek. ⁴As they went on their way through the cities, they delivered to them for observance the decisions that had been reached by the apostles and elders who were in Jerusalem. ⁵So the churches were strengthened in the faith, and they increased in numbers daily.

Holy Baptism

The Exhortation

- The Celebrant then says to the People

Dearly beloved, Scripture teaches that we were all dead in our sins and trespasses, but by grace we may be saved through faith. Our Savior Jesus Christ said, "Unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God"; and He commissioned the Church to "make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." Here we ask our heavenly Father that Charlotte Hall Radabaugh, being baptized with water, may be filled with the Holy Spirit, born again, and received into the Church as a living member of Christ's body. Therefore, I urge you to call upon God the Father, through our Lord Jesus Christ, that of His abundant mercy He will grant to Charlotte that which by nature she cannot have.

The Presentation

- The Celebrant says

The Candidate for Holy Baptism will now be presented.

- The parents and Sponsors say

We present Charlotte Hall Radabaugh to receive the Sacrament of Baptism.

- The Celebrant continues.

Today, on behalf of Charlotte you shall make vows to renounce the devil and all his works, to trust God wholeheartedly, and to serve Him faithfully. It is your task to see that this child is taught, as soon as she is able to learn, the meaning of all these vows, and of the Faith that you will profess as revealed in the Holy Scriptures. She must come to put her faith in Jesus Christ, and learn the Creeds, the Lord's Prayer, the Ten Commandments, and all other things that a Christian ought to know, believe, and do for the welfare of her soul. When she has embraced all these, she is to come to the Bishop to be confirmed, that she may publicly claim the Faith for her own and be further strengthened by the Holy Spirit to serve Christ and His kingdom.

Are you willing and ready to undertake this?

- Sponsors and Sponsoring Parents say

I am, the Lord being my helper.

Profession of Faith

- The Celebrant then examines the Sponsors and Sponsoring Parents who will speak on behalf of infants or young children, saying

Question: Answer:	Do you renounce the devil and all the spiritual forces of wickedness that rebel against God? <i>I renounce them.</i>
Question:	Do you renounce the empty promises and deadly deceits of this world that corrupt and destroy the creatures of God?
Answer:	I renounce them.
Question:	Do you renounce the sinful desires of the flesh that draw you from the love of God?
Answer:	I renounce them.

- The Celebrant prays over the Candidate.

Almighty God deliver you from the powers of darkness and evil, and lead you into the light and obedience of the kingdom of His Son Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

- The Celebrant continues.

Question: Do you turn to Jesus Christ and confess Him as your Lord and Savior? *Answer: I do.*

Question: Do you joyfully receive the Christian Faith, as revealed in the Holy Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments?

- Answer: I do.
- *Question:* Will you obediently keep God's holy will and commandments, and walk in them all the days of your life?

Answer: I will, the Lord being my helper.

- The Celebrant then addresses the Congregation, first inviting them to stand.

Will you who witness these vows do all in your power to support Charlotte in her life in Christ? *Congregation: We will.*

- The Celebrant then says

Let us join with Charlotte to proclaim our faith in the words of the ancient baptismal confession, the Apostles' Creed.

Celebrant: <i>People:</i>	Do you believe and trust in God the Father? <i>I do.</i> <i>I believe in God the Father almighty,</i> <i>creator of heaven and earth.</i>
Celebrant: <i>People:</i>	Do you believe and trust in Jesus Christ? I do. I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the Holy Spirit And born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, Was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended to the dead. On the third day He rose again. He ascended into heaven, And is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead.

Celebrant: Do you believe and trust in the Holy Spirit? **People:** I do. I believe in the Holy Spirit, The holy catholic Church, The forgiveness of sins, The resurrection of the body, And the life everlasting. Amen.

Litany for the Candidate

- The Celebrant continues.

Let us now pray for Charlotte who is to receive the Sacrament of Baptism.

Celebrant: <i>People:</i>	That she may come to confess her faith in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior. <i>We beseech You to hear us, Good Lord.</i>
Celebrant: <i>People:</i>	That she may continue in the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in the prayers. <i>We beseech You to hear us, Good Lord.</i>
Celebrant: <i>People:</i>	That she may walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which she has been called, ever growing in faith and all heavenly virtues. <i>We beseech You to hear us, Good Lord.</i>
Celebrant: <i>People:</i>	That she may persevere in resisting evil, and, whenever she falls into sin, repent and return to the Lord. <i>We beseech You to hear us, Good Lord.</i>
Celebrant:	That she may proclaim by word and deed the Good News of God in Christ Jesus to a lost and broken world.
People:	We beseech You to hear us, Good Lord.

Celebrant: <i>People:</i>	That as a living member of the Body of Christ, she may grow up in every way into Him who is the head. <i>We beseech you to hear us, Good Lord.</i>
Celebrant: <i>People:</i>	That, looking to Jesus, she may run with endurance the race set before her, and at the last receive the unfading crown of glory. <i>We beseech you to hear us, Good Lord.</i>

- The Celebrant continues in prayer.

Let us pray.

Almighty and everlasting Father, in Your great mercy You saved Noah and his family in the Ark from the destruction of the flood, prefiguring the Sacrament of Holy Baptism. Look mercifully upon this Your servant. Wash and sanctify her through Your Holy Spirit, that she may be delivered from destruction and received into the Ark of Christ's Church; and being steadfast in faith, joyful through hope, and rooted in love, she may pass through the turbulent floods of this troublesome world and come into the land of everlasting life, through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

We thank You, Almighty God, for the gift of water. Over it the Holy Spirit moved in the beginning of creation. Through it You led the children of Israel out of their bondage in Egypt into the land of promise. In it Your Son Jesus received the baptism of John in the River Jordan when the Holy Spirit descended upon Him as a dove.

We thank You, Father, for the water of Baptism. In it we are buried with Christ in His death. By it we share in His resurrection. Through it we are made regenerate by the Holy Spirit. Therefore in joyful obedience to Your Son, we bring into His fellowship those who come to Him in faith, baptizing them in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

Now, Father, sanctify this water by the power of Your Holy Spirit. May all who are baptized here be cleansed from sin, be born again, and continue for ever faithful in the risen life of Jesus Christ our Savior. To Him, to You, and to the Holy Spirit, be all honor and glory, now and for ever. **Amen.**

The Baptism

Charlotte, receive the sign of the Cross as a token of your new life in Christ, in which you shall not be ashamed to confess the faith of Christ crucified, to fight bravely under His banner against the world, the flesh, and the devil, and to continue as His faithful soldier and servant to the end of your days. **Amen.**

Heavenly Father, we thank You that by water and the Holy Spirit You have bestowed upon this Your servant the forgiveness of sin, received her as Your own child by adoption, made her a member of Your holy Church, and raised her to the new life of grace. Sustain her, O Lord, in Your Holy Spirit, that she may enjoy everlasting salvation through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

- The Celebrant continues.

Let us welcome the newly baptized.

-Celebrant and People:

We receive you into the fellowship of the Church. Confess the faith of Christ crucified, proclaim His resurrection, and share with us in the royal priesthood of all His people.

Holy and gracious Father: In your infinite love you made us for yourself; and when we had sinned against you and become subject to evil and death, you, in your mercy, sent your only Son into the world for our salvation. By the Holy Spirit and the Virgin Mary he became flesh and dwelt among us. In obedience to your will, he stretched out his arms upon the cross and offered himself once for all, that by his suffering and death we might be saved. By his resurrection he broke the bonds of death, trampling Hell and Satan under his feet. As our great high priest, he ascended to your right hand in glory, that we might come with confidence before the throne of grace.

On the night that he was betrayed, our Lord Jesus Christ took bread; and when he had given thanks, he broke it, and gave it to his disciples, saying, "Take, eat; this is my Body which is given for you: Do this in remembrance of me."

Likewise, after supper, Jesus took the cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them, saying, "Drink this, all of you; for this is my Blood of the New Covenant, which is shed for you, and for many, for the forgiveness of sins: Whenever you drink it, do this in remembrance of me."
